Sharing the Site

- Outline of Other Building Purposes
 - Community meeting spaces
 - Training courses
 - o Rental
 - o Offices for Belong NDIS consultation, social work client meetings
 - Other community uses?
- Principle: all groups maintain the space they use
 - o Cleaners on Sunday evening to clean after weekend hire
 - Training courses do they following this principle?
 - Shared facilities e.g. toilets, lawn who is responsible?
- Belong have raised concerns that we need to be more respectful of their office space
 - o e.g. NDIS clients may be deterred if they do not find the space "professional"
 - Do we need clearer information or guidelines on site use?

Inclusivity of Space

- Who are the most important groups to welcome?
- Are there groups that dominate (and make the space less inclusive)?
- Vulnerable people: what support do we need?
- Do we need some practical codes to follow?

COVID Restrictions

- Full compliance is very involved
 - Too much work for possible easing by 22 January?
- Simplify for ease of implementation?
 - Stay away if unwell
 - Up to 20 people outside
 - No indoor gatherings
 - Seated dining only
 - Hand sanitisers on counter and on every table
 - Maximum of three people in kitchen
 - Masks to be worn at all times
 - One person ordering at a time
 - Make sure contact tracing forms are filled
 - Mark 1.5m distances on ground with tape
 - Display signage from 2020
